The Advanced Diploma of Leadership and Management, delivered by NV Education and Training Services (NVETS), is specifically designed to meet the needs of the volunteer program managers who are interested in a general management and leadership qualifications.

We focus on leadership in the community services sector however the qualification itself will challenge your thinking and encourage you to think outside of the box. Skills acquired through this qualification have a very strong application, they are current, evidenced based, and are very important elements of the program for those working in the community services field.

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who apply specialised knowledge and skills, along with relevant experience in leadership and management. At this level you will be using initiative and effective judgment to plan and implement a range of leadership and management functions, with accountability for personal and team outcomes.

To maximise your learning and professional development, the Volunteer Program Managers will need experience in managing volunteers for at least 2 years in a professional capacity and currently working in a role providing oversight or management of volunteer programs.

Packaging Rules:

This qualification has 12 units in total;

- 4 core units and
- 8 elective units

Elective units will enable specialisation in volunteer management and provide the opportunity to support the individuals and the organisations based on their management practices and systems and procedures.

The training will involve a mix of workshops and individual tasks and projects directly related to your workplace. It requires a minimum of 14 days of direct training, face to face, plus individual projects and tasks, and learning is support accessible.

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Our trainers and assessors are highly qualified and experienced volunteer program managers who have been successfully managing medium to large size programs, and possess a wealth of knowledge related to leadership and management.

Interested participants will be provided with the assessment to identify their eligibility for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), Recognition of Current Competences (RCC) and Credit Transfer (CT), and will be informed if qualify and eligible.

Upon completion of this qualification, the participants may select to complete BSB62015 Advanced Diploma of Community Sector Management through credit transfer and completion of additional units, and there will be additional cost associated with it.
